<b>Support</b>	Research is well supported with documentation, logic, and reasoning	Research is supported with documentation, logic, and reasoning	Research is supported with very little documentation, logic, and reasoning	Research is supported with little or no documentation, logic, and reasoning
<b>Presentation</b>	Students are poised (eye contact, gestures, voice), give concrete examples, and answer questions accurately	Students are poised (eye contact, gestures, voice) much of the time, give examples, and answer questions accurately	Students are only somewhat poised (eye contact, gestures, voice) give few examples, or do not always answer questions correctly	Students are not poised (eye contact, gestures, voice) give few or no examples, and/or do not answer questions correctly
